Call to Order-The meeting was called to order at 7:04 pm, with the Pledge of Allegiance. After the Pledge, Mrs. Wilkinson asked for another moment of silence for Ukraine.

Approval of the Minutes-Mr. Bryant made a motion to accept the May, 2022 minutes, and dispense with the reading of them, seconded by Mr. Rayder, and carried.

Dept Head Reports:

Fire Dept- Bradner Whaley passed out the chief's report to the supervisor, board members, and clerk. There were 27 total calls. A firefighter wants to take EMT training, which can be costly. Mrs. Wilkinson made the motion that the town set aside up to \$1,700.00, for EMT training, for 1 firefighter. Her motion was seconded by Mr. Rayder, and carried. Mr. Whaley also mentioned that a community brunch will be held on June 26, 2022, from 11-2, to help out an injured firefighter.

Legislator-Dave Holst was not present at the meeting, but Mrs. Wilkinson had talked to him about the mowing and snow contracts with the county, and he said he had a meeting coming up, and would see what he could find out.

Highway Dept.- Mr. Perkins reported that ½ mile on N. Hillsboro, and ½ mile on Tanner Road have been paved. He said that spray patching repairs are being done on Little Pond Road, and Mellon Road, and he plans on repairing culverts on Frank Bryant, and Turk Roads. Mrs. Wilkinson also mentioned that the outdoor lighting at the town hall will be replaced, and asked Mr. Perkins if the sodium vapor lights could be advertised on Auctions International?

Code Enforcement-Mr. Marsden was not at the meeting, but had given a report to Mrs. Wilkinson. He has issued 5 new building permits, has issued citations on 5 properties, and has 66 open permits. He reported that a couple of the properties are starting to clean things up.

a public hearing would be held before next month's board meeting, at 6:00 pm. A notice will be put in the paper. Mr. Cronk stated that his club is licensed and insured, and they close down riding by 9 pm. Mrs. Wilkinson asked for a map of the locations, and asked Mr. Cronk to be at the public hearing, to answer questions. He stated that if he couldn't be there, the vice president of the club would attend.

Approval of the Bills-Mr. Bryant made the motion to approve General Fund vouchers #110-134, in the amount of \$6,616.59, seconded by Mr. Rayder, and carried. Mrs. Humphries made the motion to approve Highway Fund vouchers #91-108, in the amount of \$29,984.69, seconded by Mr. Rayder, and carried.

Supervisor's Report-Balance sheets and reconciliation summaries are provided, and a copy of the full monthly financial statement is provided. A copy of all financial reports are available from either Ms. Butler, town accounting officer, or from the supervisor.

Adjournment-At 8:18 pm, Mr Bryant made the motion to adjourn. It was seconded by Mr. Rayder, and carried.
