Call to Order-The meeting was called to order at 7:08 pm., by Mrs. Wilkinson, who asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of the Minutes-Mr. Bryant made a motion to accept the January, 2023 minutes, and dispense with the reading of them, seconded by Mr. Stone, and carried.

Dept Head Reports:

Fire Dept- Bradner Whaley passed out the chief's report to the Supervisor, board members, and clerk. He also reported that the department now has 2 new EMTs, which brings the total number now to 4. Mr. Whaley also invited the entire board to the fire dept. banquet, which is going to be held on April 1st. On the Chief's report, there were 29 total calls.

Legislator-Dave Holst was not present. No report given.

Highway Dept- Mr. Perkins reported that he had gotten some quotes on new trucks, and the price just keeps going up. Onondaga County state bid will run out in June. Mr. Perkins reported that the town has purchased a hot box, so potholes can be repaired. As far as the overhead door bids, Mr. Perkins said he is getting some. The bids will be opened at the March board meeting.

Tug Hill-Mr. Baxter provided a written report for the supervisor, board members, and clerk. He reported on the Tug Hill's webinar on knowledge transfer, that is scheduled for Tuesday, February 28th, at 6:00 pm, via Zoom. Registration is required, and Mr. Baxter said this topic would also be covered at the Local Government Conference, in April. Mr. Baxter also provided a revised and updated paper that is out on towns and cemeteries, and state laws, and gave a copy to Mrs. Wilkinson.
