Call to Order-The meeting was called to order at 6:58 pm., by Mrs. Wilkinson, who asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of the Minutes-Mr. Bryant made a motion to accept the June, 2023 minutes, and dispense with the reading of them, seconded by Mr. Rayder, and carried.

Dept Head Reports:

Fire Dept- Bradford Whaley passed out the chief's report for June. There were 27 total calls, including 1 structure fire, 3 MVAs, and 14 EMS calls. The department will be having a car show on Saturday, August 12th, from 11am-5pm, with a rain date of August 19th. The heavy rescue vehicle is there, and Bruce Walters from the Panther Lake Association said he has spoken with Chris Race, a fire dept. member, asking for a list of needs for the rescue vehicle, that possibly the Association could help provide. Mr. Walters also mentioned that there is a person living on the lake, who is a grant writer, and could possibly help the fire dept. write some grants.

Legislator-Dave Holst was not present, no report was given.

Highway Dept.- Mr. Perkins reported that he had "put a bandaid" on Little Pond Road, and it would be good, for now. Mr. Perkins hopes to start spray patching, next Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, and he would like to seal as many roads as possible. He reported that he had received a bid from Midland of \$20,000.00, to motopave the driveway at the town garage. Mrs. Wilkinson said that it would need to be put out for bids.
