Call to Order-The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm., by Mrs. Wilkinson, who asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dept Head Reports:

Fire Dept- Bradner Whaley handed out the chief's report to the supervisor, board members, and clerk. There were 43 total calls, 23 of those being EMS calls. 14 calls were canceled enroute. Mr. Whaley also brought the budget request for 2024, to the meeting, and reported that Terry Clark has resigned as fire chief.

Legislator-Dave Holst was not present, no report was given.

Highway Dept.-Mr. Perkins reported that the parking lot at the Highway Garage is all sealed, and the parking space closest to the pavilion has been sealed. Mrs. Wilkinson asked if there were any handicap parking signs, and Mr. Perkins said he thought he might have some. He reported that a bearing on the screener was gone, but not a big deal, he felt that they could purchase the part, and repair it themselves. He reported that they will be screening sand, and when that is done, will start cutting brush and trees for firewood, for the winter.
