Call to Order-The meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm, by Mrs. Wilkinson, with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes-Mr. Rayder made a motion to accept the September 2025 minutes, and dispense with the reading of them, seconded by Mr. Stone and carried.

Dept Head Reports:

Fire Dept- Chris Race reported that the department has received 342 calls this year, as of tonight. They will be holding their Halloween event, on Halloween night. They are also selling raffle tickets for a drawing for a turkey dinner. Still waiting on defibrillator parts.

Legislator- Dave Holst was not present, no report was given.

Highway Dept.- Mr. Perkins reported that the new trucks are supposed to be in this week. They fixed the one sander from Hastings and put it on the 2021 truck. They are using a borrowed truck from Mexico, for now. Mrs. Wilkinson asked if the 2013 and 2005 trucks were going to be put on Auctions International? Mr. Perkins replied that he can't put the '05 on, as the town doesn't have a clear title. He will investigate trying to get the title. He reported that salt started being delivered today, and he still has nothing from the county on the snow contract for this winter. Heidi Tompkins reported that Tug Hill sent out quite a lengthy email to the Oswego County legislature explaining how important it is for the different towns to get this contract in place.

Tug Hill-Heidi Tompkins read from the Salmon Rivers Council of Governments Monthly Bulletin. – She mentioned Connor Moulton, who is interning at the Tug Hill, under the direction of Heidi, and Jillian Lee. Connor goes to school at Syracuse University, and is vice president of Engineers Without Borders, at the university. The NorCOG & SRCG Annual Dinner will be held October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025, in Cleveland, N.Y., at the North Riding Barn.

Code Enforcement- Mr. Marsden issued 6 building permits and 2 violations.

Planning Board- The board now consists of Brandy Wheeler, and Chris Race. So, Brandy submitted an application from Chris Race, for a fence building permit. The planning board no longer has a quorum, so the application must default to the town board. Mrs. Wilkinson made a motion to accept the application, seconded by Mr. Rayder. ROLL CALL: Mr. Rayder-aye, Mr. Stone-aye, and Mrs. Wilkinson-aye. Motion carried. A public hearing will be held on Monday, October 27, 2025, at 6:00 p.m., at the town hall.

Dog Control-Relatively quiet.

Town Clerk- Took in a total of \$356.00, for September 2025. The fees included 10 dog licenses, and 4 miscellaneous revenues (building permits). A check for \$344.00 was given to the supervisor, and \$12.00 went to the Animal Population Control Program in Albany.

Old Business- The budget workshop scheduled for Thursday, October 23, 2025, has been canceled.

New Business- The next budget workshop has been rescheduled to Monday, October 27, 2025, at 6:15 pm, immediately following the public hearing for Chris Race's fence building permit application. Mrs. Wilkinson also made a motion to adopt a resolution to go over the tax cap, if needed. Her motion was seconded by Mr. Stone. ROLL CALL: Mr. Rayder-aye, Mr. Stone-aye, and Mrs. Wilkinson-aye. Motion carried.

Open to the Public- Chris Race brought up a drawing, and map of where he wants to build the fence and gave it to Mrs. Wilkinson.

Approval of the Bills – Mr. Rayder made the motion to approve General Fund vouchers # 158-179, in the amount of \$13,290.01 seconded by Mr. Stone, and carried. Mr. Stone made the motion to approve Highway Fund vouchers #197-211, in the amount of \$33,847.51, seconded by Mr. Rayder and carried.

Supervisor's Report-Balance sheets and reconciliation summaries are provided, and a copy of the full months' financial statement is provided. A **copy** of all financial reports is available from either Ms. Butler, town accounting officer, or from the supervisor.

Adjournment-At 7:50 pm, Mr. Stone motioned to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Rayder, and carried.
