Call to Order-The meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm, by Mrs. Wilkinson, with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes-Mr. Bryant made a motion to accept the October 2025 minutes, and dispense with the reading of them, seconded by Mrs. Humphries and carried.

Dept Head Reports:

Fire Dept- No one from the fire dept was at the beginning of the meeting, as they were out on a call. When they came, Corey Douglas gave the chief's report to Mrs. Wilkinson, and Mrs. Humphries. The report was for the past 2 months. Mr. Douglas said things are going good, and they are having a raffle to win a turkey dinner, with the drawing on Wednesday. They are still waiting on batteries for the defibrillator, as the first battery sent was the wrong size.

Legislator- Dave Holst was not present, no report was given.

Highway Dept.- Mr. Perkins reported that the new trucks won't be ready now, until the end of December! Mr. Perkins said he would have to pick up Mexico's truck, and that way he'll have at least 2 trucks. Mrs. Wilkinson asked what we would have to give Mexico in return, and Mr. Perkins said nothing, they used our hotbox over the summer, so borrowing their truck is not a problem. The county sent out the 3<sup>rd</sup> snow contract for the year, it should be the final one. Mr. Perkins will be returning it to Oswego tomorrow.

Tug Hill-Heidi Tompkins read from the Salmon Rivers Council of Governments Monthly Bulletin. She said they are looking for a part time associate circuit rider, to assist with meeting coverage and support. \$19.00 per hour, plus mileage. Heidi reported that the 2026 Local Government Conference will be held on April 20-21, 2026, at the Turning Stone Resort Casino, in Verona.

Code Enforcement- Mr. Marsden issued 6 building permits.

Planning Board- The board no longer has enough members, but they still get questions. Brandy Wheeler said that a gentleman had asked her about doing a small subdivision on Harry Bryant Rd., so she told him what he would need.

Dog Control-Relatively quiet.

Town Clerk- Took in a total of \$177.00 for October 2025. The fees included 4 dog licenses, and 3 miscellaneous revenues (building permits). A check for \$169.00 was given to the supervisor, and \$8.00 went to the Animal Population Control Program in Albany.

Old Business- Mrs. Wilkinson said she really didn't have any old business.

New Business- Dick Bryant made the motion to adopt the budget for 2026, seconded by Mrs. Humphries. **ROLL CALL:** Mr. Bryant-yes, Mr. Rayder-yes, Mr. Stone-yes, Mrs. Humphries-yes, and Mrs. Wilkinson-yes. All in favor, motion carried, 2026 budget adopted.

Open to the Public- No questions or comments.

Approval of the Bills – Mr. Stone made the motion to approve General Fund vouchers # 180-198, in the amount of \$74,522.68, seconded by Mr. Rayder, and carried. Mr. Bryant made the motion to approve Highway Fund vouchers #212-224, in the amount of \$14,841.83, seconded by Mrs. Humphries, and carried. Mrs. Wilkinson mentioned that \$55,000.00 of the General Fund total was a payment to the State Retirement Fund.

Supervisor's Report-Balance sheets and reconciliation summaries are provided, and a copy of the full months' financial statement is provided. A **copy** of all financial reports is available from either Ms. Butler, town accounting officer, or from the supervisor.

Adjournment-At 7:55 pm, Mr. Bryant motioned to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Rayder, and carried.
