Call to Order-The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm, by Mrs. Humphries, with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes-Mr. Whaley made a motion to accept the December 2025 minutes, and dispense with the reading of them, seconded by Mrs. Wheeler and carried.

Dept Head Reports:

Fire Dept- Corey Douglas reported that the department has received 21 calls so far, not much of anything else going on.

Legislator- Dave Holst was not at the meeting. No report was given.

Highway Dept- Mr. Perkins reported that the new trucks have finally been delivered. He also reported that several items have been put on Auctions International including: 2013 International 10-wheeler with plow equipment, 2005 International 10-wheeler, 2001 International 6-wheeler, 1988 Oshkosh 6-wheeler, and two 1-way plows. Mr. Perkins also reported that he had ordered another 3 tons of salt, which would cost approximately \$18,000.00

Tug Hill-Rodney Campbell read from the Salmon Rivers Council of Governments Monthly Bulletin. He reported on upcoming events including NorCOG winter meeting at the West Monroe Town Building at 6:30 pm, on February 26<sup>th</sup>, SRCG Winter Meeting at 6:30pm, on February 25<sup>th</sup>, at the Pulaski Village Building, and the THC Local Government Conference April 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup>, at Turning Stone Resort Casino.

Code Enforcement- Mr. Marsden was not at the meeting. No report was given.

Planning Board- Chris Race reported that the board received a subdivision application this evening. It was basically to move a line, he said a public hearing would not be necessary.

Dog Control- Relatively quiet. Mr. Conover had received only 1 call for a dog running loose on County Route 23.

Town Clerk- Took in a total of \$1,048.00 for December 2025. A check for \$1,045.00 was given to the supervisor, and \$3.00 was mailed to Animal Population Control in Albany.

Tax Collector- The tax collector has taken in \$407,569.42 so far, with outstanding taxes of \$1,354,569.42 left to be paid. She also asked for a resolution to be passed, which reads as follows: **Be it resolved that the Town of Amboy does charge a fee of two dollars (\$2.00) to be added to the tax due on all properties for which a second notice is sent, on or about March 15<sup>th</sup>, for the Town and County tax bills for the year 2026.** Mrs. Wheeler made the motion to adopt the resolution, seconded by Mrs. Babcock. **ROLL CALL:** Mrs. Humphries-yes, Mrs. Wheeler-yes, Mr. Rayder-yes, Mrs. Babcock-yes, and Mr. Whaley-yes. Motion carried.

Old Business- Mrs. Humphries said she really didn't have any old business.

New Business- Mrs. Humphries said she also didn't have any new business.

Open to the Public- Tom Vona was at the meeting, and wanted to know if the town was still interested in having the park surveyed? Mrs. Wheeler asked how much it would cost, and Mr. Vona said there would be no charge. He was told yes, that would be something the Town would still be interested in.

Approval of the Bills – Mrs. Babcock made the motion to approve General Fund vouchers # 1-16, in the amount of \$6,199.92, seconded by Mrs. Wheeler and carried. Mr. Rayder made the motion to approve Highway Fund vouchers #1-21, in the amount of \$22,565.85 seconded by Mr. Whaley and carried.

Adjournment-At 7:18 pm, Mr. Whaley motioned to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Rayder, and carried.
