Call to Order-The meeting was called to order at 7:04 pm, by Mrs. Humphries, with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes-Mr. Whaley made a motion to accept the February 2026 minutes, and dispense with the reading of them, seconded by Mr. Rayder and carried.

Dept Head Reports:

Fire Dept- Corey Douglas reported that the department has received 74 total calls so far, and an Easter egg hunt will be held at the firehouse on March 28th, at 3:00 pm.

Legislator- Dave Holst brought some information to the meeting about ATVs on the roads, for the board members to look over, and was interested in hearing the discussion about allowing them on town roads.

Highway Dept.- Mr. Perkins reported that he had spoken with Ricelli's, and they plan on paving Finnerty Rd. Their blacktop plant opens April 15th, and Mr. Perkins will have a better idea when they will be paving, after the plant opens. He reported he has been getting quotes for paving on Harry Bryant Road, and is thinking of possibly paving Foil Road, next year. Mr. Perkins said there are several Maple trees that need cutting down, and they will also be doing some ditching. Mr. Perkins also reported that a hydraulic tank on the sweeper blew, and the cost to replace it would be \$2,129.00. Mrs. Babcock made the motion to replace the tank for that cost, seconded by Mr. Whaley, and carried.

Tug Hill- Rodney Campbell from Tug Hill gave the report from the monthly bulletin. Both NorCOG, and SRCG held their winter meetings, and SRCG welcomed the Town of Sandy as a new member. SRCG will be holding their Spring meeting on May 27th, at 6:30 pm, at the Amboy Town Hall, and NorCOG will hold their Spring meeting on May 28th, at 6:30 pm, at the Village of Cleveland Office Building.

Code Enforcement- Mr. Marsden was not at the meeting. No report was given.

Planning Board- Chris Race reported that the Planning Board didn't have a quorum, so they didn't have a meeting.

Dog Control- Clayton Conover told Mrs. Humphries that there are dogs in containers at a House on Little Pond Rd., and he is still trying to figure out what is going on. The kennel on his property passed inspection, so Amboy should be in good shape, if a dog needs to be held in a kennel.

Town Clerk- Took in a total of \$122.00 for February 2026. A check for \$115.00 was given to the supervisor, and \$7.00 was mailed to Animal Population Control in Albany.

Tax Collector- The tax collector has taken in \$1,506,616.03, with \$256,867.13, still outstanding.

Old Business- Jay Bergen came back to the meeting. He said he had sent a letter to the owners of Jamieson Corners, and they were excited, and said they would open the property in back of the store where a trail leads to Cable Road. He was asked if it was an old snowmobile trail. He said yes, he believed so, and was told that trail leads to 17A, not Cable Road. Mrs. Humphries told him that the board hadn't reached a decision yet, and they wanted to wait until Mrs. Wheeler was back from vacation, as they have more information to look over, and Mrs. Humphries said the topic was going to be covered at the Local Government Conference, and they wanted to gather information from there, also. Mr. Bergen asked if he could go to the conference, and after a short discussion, it was determined that he could go. He gave the application fee to Mrs. Humphries.

New Business- Mrs. Humphries said she didn't have any new business.

Open to the Public- No questions or comments.

Approval of the Bills – Mr. Whaley made the motion to approve General Fund vouchers # 40-56, in the amount of \$39,790.50, seconded by Mr. Rayder, and carried. Mr. Rayder made the motion to approve Highway Fund vouchers #51-78, in the amount of \$62,018.39 seconded by Mr. Whaley, and carried.

Adjournment-At 7:33 pm, Mrs. Humphries motioned to adjourn, seconded by Mrs. Babcock and carried.
