Call to Order-The meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm, by Mrs. Humphries, with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes-Mr. Rayder made a motion to accept the May 2026 minutes, seconded by Mrs. Wheeler and carried.

Dept Head Reports:

Fire Dept- No one from the department was present, no report was given.

Legislator- Dave Holst has passed away. His wife Patti will be sworn in on July 9th, 2026, to take his place for the rest of his term and will run for the position in November 2026.

Highway Dept.- Mr. Perkins had a medical issue to deal with, and was excused from the meeting. No report was given.

Tug Hill- Rodney Campbell from Tug Hill gave the report from the monthly bulletin. The next NorCog meeting will be held on July 30th. New amendments were adopted to SEQR, and the amendments went into effect on Friday, June 12th, 2026. Consolidated Funding Applications are now open, and any applications are due by Friday, July 31st, 2026 at 4 pm. Budgeting & Accounting Training for small towns, with Laird Petrie will be held Thursday, June 18th, 9 am-5pm, and Friday, June 19th, from 8am-4pm. Cost is \$125 per person. Mrs. Humphries plans on attending.

Code Enforcement- 1 Building permit was issued, 6 violations were issued, and a couple of legal letters were sent out. Mr. Marsden was not at the meeting.

Planning Board- Chris Race was not at the meeting. A subdivision application will be given to him, for next month.

Dog Control- There was an incident on Little Pond Road, but Mr. Conover took care of it.

Town Clerk- Took in a total of \$360.00 for May 2026. A check for \$349.00 was given to the supervisor, and \$11.00 was mailed to Animal Population Control in Albany.

Old Business- None

New Business- Mrs. Humphries didn't have any new business.

Open to the Public- Clinton Sampson asked about Ricellis. He was told they had repaired the road on Finnerty, somewhat, and Mrs. Humphries and Mr. Perkins will be meeting with them tomorrow morning, at the Town Hall.

Approval of the Bills – Mr. Rayder made the motion to approve General Fund vouchers # 93-109, in the amount of \$7,674.88, seconded by Mrs. Babcock, and carried. Mrs. Wheeler made the motion to approve Highway Fund vouchers #134-154 in the amount of \$84,248.73 seconded by Mrs. Babcock, and carried.
